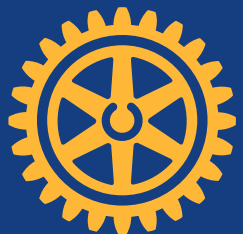

What It Means to be a Rotarian:

Classic City Rotary Club welcomes membership proposals for people “who demonstrate **good character, integrity, and leadership**; possess a good reputation within their business, profession, and/or community; and are willing to **serve in their community** and/or around the world.” Proposals are reviewed and approved by the Membership Committee, Board of Directors, and Club membership.

Expectations & Commitment:

As part of Classic City Rotary, you will be asked to **pay quarterly dues** (which include dues for Rotary International and our district, as well as our club operations and weekly meetings); to be active, **attending our meetings and events** (with a goal of 50% attendance); and to use your **skills and talents** to enhance our club and our service activities. Members also sell tickets for **one fundraiser per year** to support service projects.

Meetings are held each Monday at 12 pm.

Membership Categories:

Active Member

Default category for new members unless otherwise requested. Quarterly fees cover meals and dues.

- \$100 Induction Fee
- \$296.50 Quarterly (includes meals)

Young Rotary Leaders

Members under 40

- Waived Induction Fee
- \$242.75 Quarterly

Shared Membership

Allows two to four people (e.g., spouses; business partners; employees of same group) to “share” membership and attendance responsibilities.

- \$100 Induction Fee
- \$369 for 2, \$445.50 for 3, or \$532 for 4 Shared Members Quarterly
- First 12 meals included with dues each quarter; \$18/meal after first 12.

Creative Class

For members in arts/music fields (e.g., visual arts, performing musicians). Must lead 1 arts-related club event/project per year; participate in 2+ other club projects annually (15+ service hours); maintain 30% attendance.

- Waived Induction Fee
- \$116 Quarterly, pre-billed monthly
- Optional meals at \$18/meal

Additionally, all Rotarians also donate at least \$27.50/quarter to The Rotary Foundation and financially support CCR fundraisers.
